How long have you been photographing weddings?	Eleven years professionally – almost 400 weddings!				
Are you a full-time photographer?	Yes, since 1999.				
Is wedding photography your primary specialty?	Yes.				
How would you describe your style?	Documentary, photojournalistic, limited posing and photographer direction.				
How can we view samples of your photography?	In person or online.				
May we view an entire wedding, not just a small portfolio?	Yes, you may request passwords to view entire weddings online. Please call or email.				
Do you have a website?	www.andypauquettephotography.com				
Are engagement or bridal portraits included?	Yes, both at your option.				
Are full-resolution digital files (“digital negatives”) included? Can we make our own prints from these files?	Yes, all full-resolution digital files are included, with permission to make unlimited prints or copies.				
Do you offer wedding albums? What type?	Yes. I offer wedding albums by Asukabook (coffee table style books) and Zookbinders (leather-bound photo albums).				
Will our photos be viewable online?	Yes, for 60 days after the event date.				
How long after the wedding will we receive our photos?	Images are usually posted online within one week of the event, and discs are shipped within 14 days.				
How many photos will we receive?	600-1800, depending on the event. These will include a variety of documentary images, posed portraits, black and white, color, etc.				
Who will actually photograph our wedding?	Andy Pauquette. I do not subcontract events or use studio photographers.				
Do you work alone?	I am accompanied by an assistant/second photographer.				
Do you bring backup equipment?	Yes. And backups of backups...				
How much time do we need to set aside for photos on the wedding day?	Typically, 20-30 minutes of the wedding day are allocated to formal (posed) portraits – this would include family groups, wedding party, bride and groom, etc.				
Do you offer a discount for non-Saturday or off-peak season weddings?	Yes – please call or email for details.
